
Tree Planting (Community Involvement)

- Not allowed with FEMA projects
- Hard to force someone out when you have a lot of willing sellers
- Is getting an "option" an option?
- Offer declined, home sells, flood, home repaired, home sells, flood... (rinse repeat)
- "Subsequent victim" syndrome

Accomplishments to Date

- \$58 million spent to date
- 392 homes removed from floodplain
- 439 parcels acquired (some back tax and donated)
- 20 mobile homes
- 66 (of 222) Repetitive Loss Properties eliminated
- ▶ 205 acres of open space created (102 acres mowed)
- 2 community gardens
- 4 projects with Greenway trails

Buyout Program is Ongoing


- Currently working with USACE in Mill Creek to purchase 44 homes (10 of 44 purchased)
- Will begin this fall to purchase 45 homes in Sevenmile Creek through USACE (future projects under discussion)
- Waiting for approval from FEMA on 4 small projects (20 homes)
- Preparing to apply for HMGP funds made available from the March 2020 tornado

Take Home Message

- Get to know Doug Worden and Amy Miller
- Identify the lowest most obvious homes in your jurisdiction (Repetitive Loss)
- Get support of community leaders
- For every \$1 spent on mitigation = \$6 of community benefit
- Put a plan together (consultant help if needed)
- Seek funding be patient
- Just Do It!


